Dear Valued Customer:

In general, the inks provided to you, as all of Superior's inks, are formulated to be environmentally responsible. They make use of vegetable oils that are renewable resources. The percentage of vegetable oil in sheetfed ink is typically 12 to 35 percent.

The Volatile Organic Compound (VOC) content of our sheetfed inks is 3 to 30 percent. Please note, that the VOC of ink is different than the actual emission into the atmosphere, when the ink is printed. For sheetfed inks, emissions are only 5 percent of the inks' total VOC.

Our inks are formulated to be in compliance with proposed and enacted CONEG legislation. As such, they are manufactured without lead, cadmium, mercury or hexavalent chromium compounds. These elements and compounds are not knowingly added to the inks, but may be present in trace quantities as contaminants in the raw materials purchased.

It is our opinion that the contaminant level of these inks is below 100 ppm (0.01%). This statement is based on vendor information and actual analytical testing performed on representative inks. Additionally, please note that our products do not contain any animal by-products.

Our products are in compliance with the current Federal laws and industry standards. In addition our suppliers have given us similar assurances covering the ingredients that comprise our inks.
